 - 4 Advanced (90-100%; mastered it)
 - 3 Proficient (70-89%; understands it)
 - 2 Basic (60-69%; needs more practice)
 - 1 Below Basic (59% or less; needs help)

- Please make sure your child completes their daily assignments and turns them in.

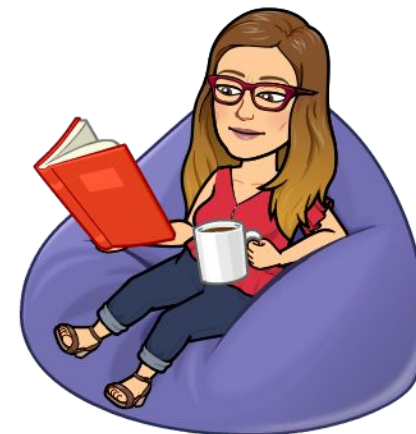
